



REDUCE EMISSIONS ON THE ROAD

Keeping up with the demand for environmentally friendly solutions, Eurofrigo has recently launched all electric refrigeration units for panel vans and box vans.

These new vehicles are designed for rural and urban multiple-drop deliveries and offer low-noise and low emission levels compared to conventional direct-drive refrigeration units.

One small speciality cheese producer, based in the South West, said, "We make a lot of town centre deliveries in the region and the fact that these fridges are very low emission appeals to us, given today's focus on the environment. We will be ordering a new chiller van later this year and will be specifying one of Eurofrigo's all electric fridges. Sainsbury's does appear to be impressed with the reduced fuel consumption and CO2 emissions that it is attaining from the units."

Many rural and urban van based delivery operations tend to be "stop start" and involve lots of individual deliveries. Because the battery drive refrigeration systems work at full capacity at all times, this offers greater temperature-stability.

Another regionally based supplier of fresh foods commented, "The extra load space that we get from the van with the Eurofrigo unit is really useful and has enabled us to cut out a complete delivery round."
